Frequently Asked Questions



- What are Wellspring's hours of Operation? -Monday – Friday, 7:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. (Afterschool until 6:00 pm)
- Where is Wellspring located? -531 Vanosdale Road, Knoxville, TN 37909
- How are tuition payments processed?
 Tuition is broken down into two monthly payments drawn via ACH from a checking account or credit card on the 1st and 15th of every month. If using a credit card, an additional 3% fee is assessed.
- Are any fees charged in addition to tuition?

-An annual \$100 registration fee is charged to cover enrollment, facility, and supply costs. For after school care, a \$50 registration fee is charged. Field trips for older children may include additional fees.

• Do you provide any tuition assistance?

-The State of Tennessee may offer a program that applies to your needs. Please mention your interest during the initial interview.

• What else is included in tuition?

-Tuition covers daily breakfast, lunch and snacks. Parents are responsible for providing any additional needs, such as formula, diapers and wipes for infants and toddlers.

• What is the ProCare App?

-We use the ProCare app to stay in contact with parents. Photos, texts, and newsletters will be exchanged to communicate. The app is also used as a contactless way to sign in/out your child. Find the ProCare app 🚳 and download it from the app store.

• Once enrolled, how do I change billing info or update individuals authorized to pickup/drop-off my child?

-On WellspringKids.com, click *Login* on the top menu. You will use the same credentials that you created when registering your child. Once logged into this parent portal, you can adjust your account info or generate billing statements.

• What curriculum is used?

-The *Experience Curriculum* includes developmentally appropriate goals and objectives for children and is directly integrated with ProCare

• What should I bring on my child's first day?

-Bring one small blanket for naptime and a change of clothes (if the child is still in diapers bring two). Blankets should be taken home every Friday or more frequently to get washed. Be sure to label sunscreen (cream) with the child's name and date of expiration.
